PreACT includes exams in English, mathematics, reading and science, just like the ACT test, but does not have a writing test. Scores will be reported on the same 1-36 scale as the ACT, but PreACT includes fewer questions and will take less time to administer than the ACT.

The PreACT is often administered during the school day, in place of other classes. The test itself takes **about 2.5 hours**, including break time, and there is an additional 60 minutes of pretest activities.

All Students should be in their assigned seats and Test administrators should start the Examinee information section portion of the test by 9am

Timing for PreACT Administration

- → Examinee information sections = approximately 60 minutes.
- → English (45 items) = 30 minutes.
- \rightarrow Math (36 items) = 40 minutes.
- → Break = 10-15 minutes.
- → Reading (25 items) = 30 minutes.
- → Science (30 items) = 30 minutes.
- → General Administration (varies) = 10 minutes.
