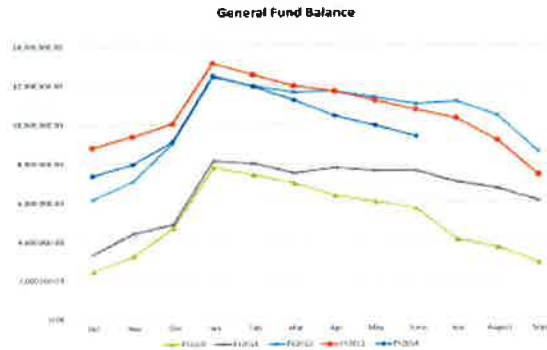
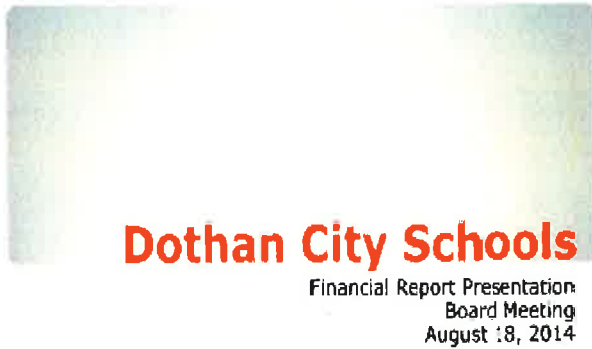

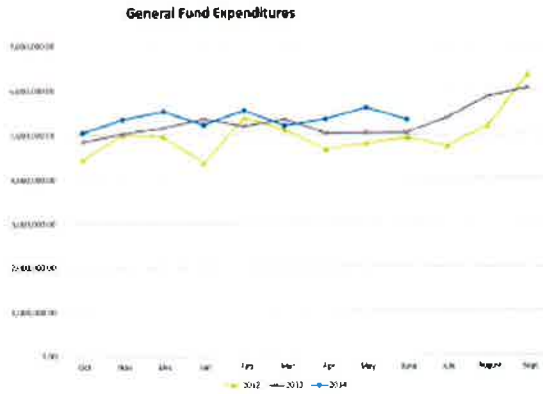
Superintendent Recommendations

Mr. Tim Wilder and Mrs. Carol Cunningham discussed the contract for therapist with SpectraCare, found it harder to get parents out there, they cut the therapist, paid about \$48,000 out of pocket last year with more therapist now looking at \$33,000, this is an excellent program, they rotate and go where the referrals are, some schools had heavier referrals and if they are 14 or older they can deny services.

Mrs. Tami Culver thank Allyson Morgan for an outstanding job done, the Adopt-A-School breakfast went well, and the DEF game \$40,000 back in 27 grants to teachers.

Mr. Tim Wilder acknowledged Mr. Kirkland and Mr. Snellgrove and all the teachers that came out.

Mr. Mike Manuel stated we need the Board to take action on taking up the basketball courts also. Mr. Tim Wilder stated his recommendation is to include the basketball court in the bid.

Mrs. Melanie Hill made a motion seconded by Mr. Franklin Jones to amend the motion to include the basketball courts as presented and as recommended by the Superintendent. The motion carried. Voting was as follows: "YEA" – Jones, Hill, Guilford, Armstrong, Maddox. "NAY" – None. "ABSTAIN" – None.


