# Dothan City Schools Behavior Flowchart

It is recommended that schools follow this flowchart to determine behaviors that warrant a behavior intervention plan through RTI or amendment to an IEP or a 504 Plan. This form is guidance for the school administration and all staff.

Non-Negotiable Code of Conduct Behaviors

Develop a Behavior Intervention Plan as soon as possible to prevent future occurrences.

Request MDR if the consequence causes a Special Education/504 student to exceed their 10 days.

## Chronic Behaviors

Any student displaying chronic behaviors should have an intervention plan through an RtI plan, 504 plan, or IEP.

### Teacher/Staff Managed Behaviors

#### Intervention I:

- Redirect Student
- Re-teach appropriate behavior to meet classroom expectations

#### Intervention 2:

- Re-teach
- Discuss behavior with student I-to-I
- Call Parent

#### Intervention 3:

- Complete Behavior Intervention Logs
- Document attempted interventions
- Determine triggers & functions of behavior
- Call Parent

#### Intervention 4:

- Refer student to SH
- Refer student to PST

#### Intervention 5:

- Complete DCS Office Referral
- Refer to Guidance Counselor
- Include all previous documentation

### Administrator Managed Behaviors

#### Teacher/Staff Intervention:

- Complete DCS Office Referral and contact office
- Conference with student
- Call Parent
- Refer student to PST/IEP/504 teams for Creation or Amendment of BIP *EVERY TIME*

### Administrator Response:

- Investigate written report
- Student conduct or BTP consulted
- Determine interventions
- Assign consequences according to DCS

- Call Parent
- Enter incident into PowerSchool
